The work to be done consists generally of: Furnishing labor and partial material for the construction of the 15kV Distribution Circuit #21 Upgrade.

The Owner reserves the right to waive any informality or to reject any and all bids. No bidder may withdraw their bid within 60 days after the actual date of the bid opening. The City may issue addenda as may be necessary in the best interest of the public and the City of Jackson. If a contract award is made, it will be made to the lowest and best, responsive, responsible bidder.
