Notice is hereby given that separate sealed bids under the Splash Pad Construction Project to serve the City of Jackson will be received in the office of the City Clerk at City Hall, 101 Court Street, Jackson, Missouri 63755, until 10:30 a.m.

(prevailing local time) on Tuesday, November 26, 2024. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at that time. The envelopes containing the bids must be sealed, addressed, and designated as bids for the “Splash Pad Construction Project; Attn: City Clerk.”

The purpose of this project is to remove the Jackson Municipal Pool kiddie pool and wading area and replace it with a new splash pad.

A pre-bid meeting will not be held. At a minimum, prospective bidders are recommended to visit the Jackson Municipal Pool site before submitting a bid. Please contact the project manager as noted below to arrange access.
